My perspective is that it's multifaceted. Individualism can denote an emphasis on personal growth, asserting that a thriving society is built upon the well-being of its individuals. Conversely, it might be perceived solipsistically, where only the self's existence or interests are paramount. The interpretation varies, highlighting the path's intricate nature.




